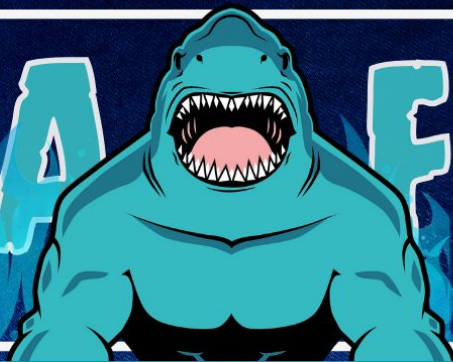


# TAWA FRENZY
