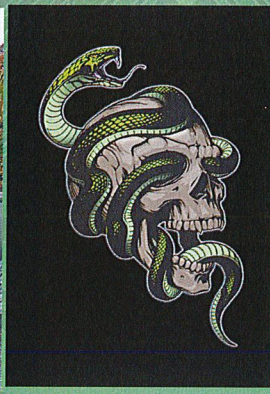

Kia ora whānau,

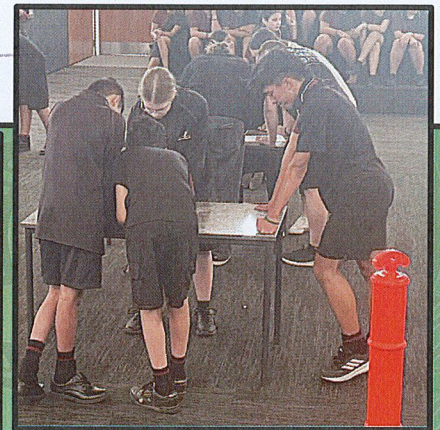
